Old Kent Leasing Services Corp. v McEwan 2001 WL 66229(TBX. App.)

Withdrawing an opinion issued only two weeks earlier, the Appellate court found that the lessor's activities in Texas were not sufficient to bring it within that state's "long-arm statute". The lessee was a California accountant and the lessor was an Illinois resident corporation. The equipment at issue was apparently manufactured in Texas.
