## General Electric Capital v. Schwegmann Giant Supermarket 2000 WL1693654 (e.d.La)

In an unusual case, summary judgment was granted to GECC enforcing not only the husband's guaranty but the wife's waiver of her community property rights under Louisiana law. Reminder: Whenever dealing with a community property state, a spousal waiver is necessary. This is directly contrary to the ECOA concept of not requiring the spouse to sign where her credit is not involved in the Guaranty.
