Wyeth Ayerst Laboratories v. Seneca Freight Lines, Inc.

The U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania denied defendant's motion to transfer this diversity action to the Northern District of Georgia. The decision was based on various private interest and public interest factors. The court gave some weight to the fact that a lease involved in the case was governed by Georgia law. However, this was balanced by another contract in the case which was governed by Pennsylvania law.
